About Workshop:

More than 50 participants from other colleges, universities and states attended the workshop. Total 9 sessions were organized in this workshop.

Day 1

The function was inaugurated in the gracious presence of Respected Dr. K. C. Mohite, Principal, C. T. Bora College, Shirur, Respected Dr. Bhujang Bobade, Knowledge resource centre, Research for Resurgence Foundation, Nagpur, Mr. Vinod Pande, Sanghatak, Bhartiya Sikshan Mandal, Nagpur, Hon. Shri Amit dada Kolhe, Managing Trustee, SGOI, Kopergaon, Dr. A.G. Thakur, Principal Sanjivani Engineering College, Kopergaon and Principals of Sanjivani College.

Dr. S. B. Dahikar addressed the session and explained the motto behind organizing the session, Dr. K. C. Mohite gave an inaugural speech and Hon Amit dada Kolhe sir in his presidential speech encourage the participants regarding the NEP 2020.

The main objective behind organizing this workshop was to foster scientific temper, to generate innovative ideas on academic and societal problems, to encourage, coordinate and implement Research and Development Programs (workshops/ seminar/ trainings), to create awareness on evolving technologies and industrial standards for products, to encourage Core Competence and Consultancy and collaborations.

First key note address was given by Dr. K. C. Mohite on “Research and Development”. In his talk he highlighted the key concepts of NEP like transforming higher education, skill



development, internship, placements, inventions and innovations, waves of innovation, Global innovation index, industry academia interactions etc.

Second key note address was given by **Dr. Bhujang Bobade** on “**Bhartiya Knowledge System**”. In his talk he gave valuable information regarding different projects like Udaan in collaboration with IIT Mumbai undertaken by him. He mentioned that the treasure of our country in the form of manuscripts, books consist of information which is to be converted into knowledge.

3rd keynote address was given by **Dr. Vinod Panday**, Prant sanghatak, bhartiya shikshan mandal pune. In his talk he gave valuable information regarding Reforms of Professional Vocation and Teachers education.
