
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

0 1 - 86 low 30%


Interpretation:

51.4 % respondents are satisfactorily agreed that teachers come with preparation for classes & 44.5 % agreed that teachers come with thoroughly.




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

63.2 % respondents are agreed that teachers communicate always effective and 28.8%& says that they are sometimes effective.




Interpretation:




43.3% respondents says that it is single antly facilitates & 43.3% says that it is very well & 11.1% says that it is moderately.

60.1% respondents say that teachers every time inform about CO's &PO's & 32% says that they are also usually informed to the says are also usually al


11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

60% respondents says that mentor takes follow-up every time & 29.7% says that they do it usually & 6.8% says that they occasionally takes follow-up.




Interpretation:

 The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.


