
An introductory speech was delivered by Dr. Madhuri Jawale, HOD of Engineering College, Kopargaon. He gave an introduction about the national women day.

- 4. Altering social traits and civic activities by constructive involvement and responsibility of men and women respectively.






- 5. Normalising a gender perspective throughout the process of development.

- Creating and expanding women's empowerment alliances and collaboration of stakeholders.


Outcomes:
